Theoriehuis.nl (Theory House) developed a unique English theory course for people in the Netherlands who do not speak Dutch (see www.theoryhouse.nl for more info). The CBR theory exam is a very difficult exam to take. The way of questioning can be hard to understand and confusing sometimes. You will have 65 questions, 25 about hazard recognition and 40 about Dutch traffic regulations. You can make 12 mistakes at hazard recognition, but only 5 at the questions about the Dutch traffic regulations. This ensures that more than 75% of all people fail the first time they take the CBR exam. We teach you the theory you need to learn to drive safely on the Dutch roads, but also we give you an exam focused training. This means that we're going to show you some questions you will get at your CBR exam and we will explain to you how to interpret those questions. The theory course is a one day training and takes the entire day (9am till 5pm). The course is usually held on Sunday's. The exam always take place the day after the course (at 11:30). The cost for a theory course including an exam is €139,50. If you fail the first time you can follow the course again for free (you only have to pay for a new exam). Besides the theory course we are mainly a driving school
