- Calender should scroll like now but on the same side as Wimdu and no transparency background

- Booking form should be opened in a popup / lightbox. (There is already a functionality for this here, originally its loaded in a popup)
- The ID should be visible in back and Frontend for like a reference number
- Then their should be a custom option build in to add some prices per person like: Cancellation insurance 7% of the price of the home + 3,50 costs & Travel insurance 2 euro per day, per person. (These amounts must be changeable per accommodation and calculated in the price
- Then all the content on the left need to be set in a div class to only have ¾ off the width so the scrolling calendar has ¼ off the width
- Info placed like this:
